Balfour Beatty Infrastructure Services, the highways management and maintenance business of Balfour Beatty plc has been awarded Wiltshire County Council's street lighting term maintenance contract.

The contract which is worth £5m over three years is potentially extendable for a further two years.

The contract, which started this month, is for the upkeep of 43,000 units across Wiltshire, and includes 24-hour emergency response, new works and replacement schemes. Although Wiltshire is a predominantly rural county, the team will also have to work in some built-up areas.

Balfour Beatty Infrastructure Service's, Street Lighting General Manager, Greg Parker said:

“This win adds to our growing portfolio of local authority street lighting contracts, and we look forward to building a strong relationship with Wiltshire County Council.”
