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ROYAL BOROUGH WIN FOR BALFOUR BEATTY

Balfour Beatty Infrastructure Services Limited (BBIS) has won the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead's term contract for highways and bridge works.

The contract, worth £15m over five years, starts this June, and carries the potential for a further five year-long extensions.

It was awarded on a 60:40 price/quality ratio, and covers schemes, surfacing and winter maintenance. BBIS will be running the contract from a depot in Stafferton Way, Maidenhead.

Bid Manager Stuart Savage said: "This very pleasing win adds to our growing portfolio of local authority work, and complements the contract we operate in nearby Wokingham.
